



# Erasmus+

**"Expert teacher in Europe - improving professional competences" (project no. 2017-1-PL01-KA101-036441, 1st June 2017 - 31st May 2019)** was aimed at the teachers of Zespół Szkół Ogólnokształcących nr 6 (Secondary School No. 6) in Bydgoszcz. Its main objective was to improve the professional competences of all the teachers involved through participation in methodology and language courses. The project results are improved quality of teaching, better quality of work and activities in favour of pupils, increased capacity to work at EU level, reinforced cooperation with partners from abroad (Erasmus+ KA2 and eTwinning), improved career prospects as well as increased motivation and satisfaction in everyday work.

There were twenty-four teachers participating in project activities. Maths/Informatics, Physics, Business Studies, Music and PE teachers as well as our school librarian (a Polish teacher in charge of the student government) attended methodology courses in the United Kingdom. They gained inspiration and teaching ideas for their classes and had an opportunity to exchange ideas and good practices with teachers from other European countries. Our foreign language teachers attended methodology courses in France, Germany, Ireland and the United Kingdom. The remaining twelve project members participated in language improvement courses. Physics, Maths, German, French, History and Social Studies and PE teachers as well as a school librarian focused on improving their English while a Polish teacher improved her German.
